

Total unemployed youth in India increased from 6.5 mn in 1993-94 to 9.5 mn in 2005-05


61% of total unemployed youth are from rural India

BVG's Story

- I started career as a Graduate Engineer Trainee in TATA Motors Ltd (TML) in 1994
- TML provided first opportunity to BVG for a facility management contract through which, BVG could give employment to a team of 8 rural youth
- With this, I, Mr. Umesh Mane and associates started BVG in 1997, in a 10 X 10 area of a cowshed in our backyard.
- With first contract of 8 people, BVG now has 35,000+ employees working with 300+ clients across 575+ sites
- Most of these employees are recruited from the rural India.
- India faces large challenge of unemployed youth. It is even more disturbing in the rural parts, as they are poor and not sufficiently educated. It is these people that were brought together, trained and deployed across the organization.


