

Heidelberg at the Heart of the Metropolitan Rhine-Neckar Region


- The Rhine-Neckar Metropolitan Region is a regional cooperation


Heidelberg, Sustainable City

- Bahnstadt: the world's largest passive house development
- Over 50 % CO₂ reduction
- Eco Green City Award (UN)
- Heidelberg is a member of the "Board of Directors" of the Energy Cities association
- Masterplan for 100 % climate protection
- One third of all Heidelberg residents primarily use public transport
- Highest proportion of cyclists in Germany (34 %)
- Heidelberg mobility network to expand the tram network

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Supporting Sustainable Management in SME: Promotion Instead of Regulation





- Supporting small and mediumsized enterprises in creating an environmental management system ("EMAS light")
- Since 2001, start-funding by DBU (125,000 €, 2 years)
- Coordination and financial support by the City of Heidelberg
- Workshops, weak point analysis and support by professional consultants

Project Elements

- 7 workshops: environmental management, environmental legislation, work safety, staff motivation, aspects of sustainable management beyond legal compliance: corporate and ecological responsibility
- 4 on-site inspections (weak point analysis): environmental impacts, energy consumption, legal compliance
- Final check by honorary "project commission": experts from local big enterprises, chamber of industry/craft, university ("godfathers" of the project)
- Award ceremony

Advantages for the Participating Enterprises



- Avoiding or reducing environmental impact
- Saving costs by reducing the consumption of resources and realizing innovative measures
- Image profit as sustainable enterprise (sales promotion, competition for trainees)
- Certainty of legal compliance
- Creating a trustful relationship between the city administration and the companies
- Positive aspect of credit scoring


Sustainable Management Network





- Informal network meetings between the head of the administration and external experts, discussing current topics, visiting selected sites
- Common events: fire protection training, eco driving lesson, support of a wheelchair basketball competition
- Continuous technical support of the participants when implementing optimization measures
- Public relations: presenting best practice measures of the participants

Project Balance



- Since 2001, more than 130 successfull participants with 9,000 employees
- One of the biggest sustainability networks of enterprises in Germany
- Reduction of CO₂ emissions: more than 2,000 tons per year
- Costs of more than 1.2 mio. Euro per year saved
- Costs for the City of Heidelberg: 50,000 Euro per year
- Total costs for the participants: 1,200 Euro per company
- Financial support of ECOfit program of the state of Baden-Württemberg – based on the Heidelberg project: 15,000
 Euro per year
- About 40 ECOfit projects in Baden-Württemberg.
